

Meeting National Curriculum Requirements for Swimming and Water Safety

Schools may choose to use the Primary PE and Sport Premium to provide additional provision for swimming but this must be for activity **over and above** the national curriculum requirements already in place in the school.

The pupil outcomes of the statements below <u>must</u> be reported on the school website for the current Year 6 cohort	
What percentage of Year 6 pupils can swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres ?	92.5%
What percentage of Year 6 pupils can use a range of strokes effectively [for example, front crawl, backstroke and breaststroke]?	73%
What percentage of Year 6 pupils can perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations?	50%

Out of the 15 non-swimmers (one registered blind) all have basic water safety skills and can tread water, get to safety and have an understanding of basic swimming strokes to get to safety.
