Objectives of Y7 Catch up funding

- To narrow the gap by providing intensive literacy and numeracy support and raise the attainment of those students entitled to the Catch up Premium
- To enhance existing provision.
- To identify concerns and target intervention and support to accelerate progress.
- To intervene quickly if any chosen strategy or intervention fails to show impact.

Funding allocation for 2017-18

How we propose to spend 2017-18 Catch-up funding		
Item	Cost	Objective
1:1 catch up literacy sessions	£9,000	To improve the reading ability of students.
Extra literacy lessons	£1,000	To raise attainment in English through longer contact time.
Small group maths lessons	£8,000	To raise attainment in maths through greater teacher contact.
Extra lesson 7 maths lessons	£975	To raise attainment in maths through longer contact time.
Numeracy resources	£1800	To improve maths skills, using techniques used in primary schools.
Mastery maths Y7 curriculum training	£200	To improve maths education in Y7.

Plan for expenditure 2017/18

- Allocate additional staff to classes with a significant number of students at level 3 in maths and English and below.
- The Y7 mastery maths curriculum: embed problem solving strategies and reasoning into Y7 lessons.
- Small group literacy lessons for catch up students.
- Weekly maths homework club.
- Train new staff to deliver mastery curriculum.
